Monday 8th – Friday 12th October

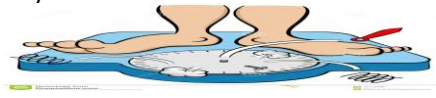
Year 6 will be having their first mock SAT's of the year this week. Please ensure the children are in school ALL week and please try to avoid any appointments.

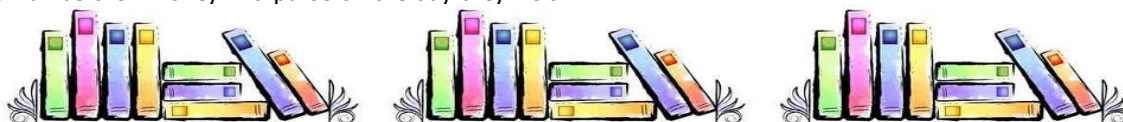
