As a school we are committed to encourage healthy and safe ways to travel to and from school. There will be 3 sessions per day, so all children have an equal amount of time.

- **1<sup>st</sup> Morning Session – 9.00am – 10.30am**  
All selected pupils attending this session must **come into school dressed in their cycling clothes**, bringing their school uniform in a carry bag to change into after their session.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Morning Session – 10.30am – 12.00pm**  
All selected pupils attending this session **must come into school in school uniform** with their cycling clothes in a bag. They will change before their session starts and change back into uniform after their session finishes.
- **Afternoon Session – 1.30pm – 3pm**  
All selected pupils attending this session must **come into school dressed in school uniform** and bring their cycling clothes in a carry bag. You will be asked to get changed at lunch time.

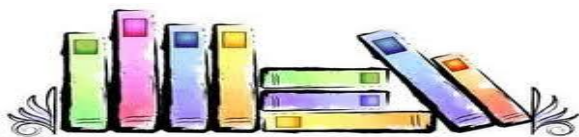
Appropriate clothing will be required that is suitable for the weather. Helmets are a must. Children will not be able participate if they do not have a helmet or a roadworthy bike.
