Tuesday 31st October 2017 - School Photographer

Our first Open Evening of the school year is to give parents and teachers the opportunity to meet and discuss how the children have progressed since the start of the school year.

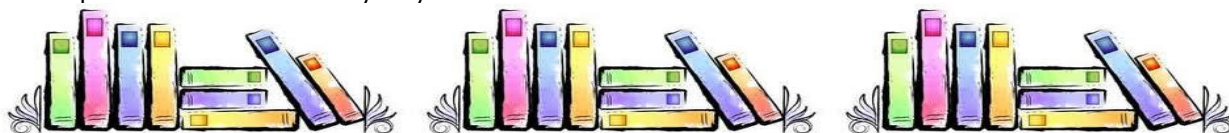
There will be an opportunity to view your child's work and to speak with the class teacher.

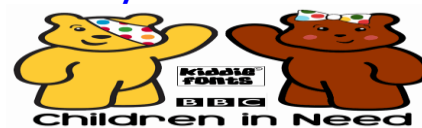
