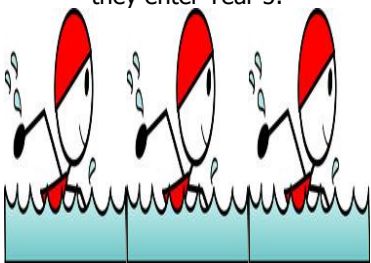
**Whole School – Summer Disco – Wednesday 24th May 2017

Father's Day BBQ & Games Afternoon Wednesday 7th June 2017 – from 2pm

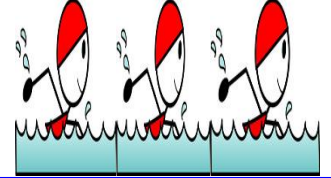

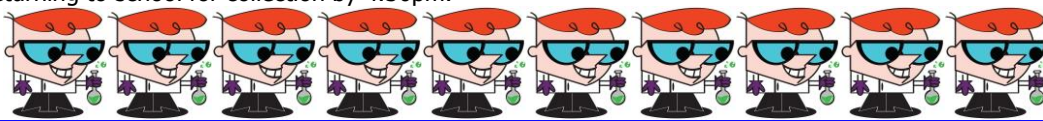
Class 4TG Commence Swimming Lessons Friday 9th June 2017
