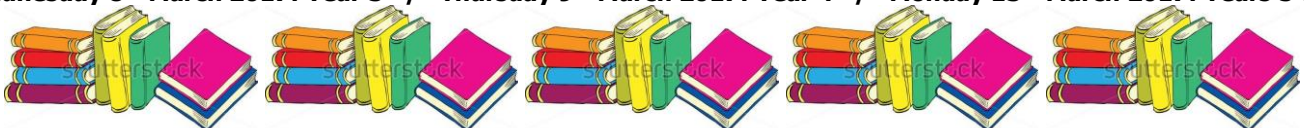

### Year 5 – Bikeability – Monday 12<sup>th</sup> March – Friday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2018

You will find overleaf, a consent letter concerning cycle training for pupils in Year 5. As a school we are committed to encourage healthy and safe ways to travel to and from school.

There will be 3 sessions per day, so all children have an equal amount of time

- **1<sup>st</sup> Morning Session – 9.00am – 10.30am**  
All selected pupils attending this session must **come into school dressed in their cycle clothes**, bringing their school uniform in a carry bag to change into after their session.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Morning Session – 10.30am – 12.00pm**  
All selected pupils attending this session **must come into school in school uniform** with their cycle clothes in a bag. They will change before their session starts and change back into uniform after their session finishes.
- **Afternoon Session – 1.30pm – 3pm**  
All selected pupils attending this session must **come into school dressed in school uniform** and bring their cycle clothes in a carry bag. You will be asked to get changed at lunch time.

Appropriate clothing will be required that is suitable for the weather. Helmets are a must. Children will not be able participate if they do not have a helmet or a roadworthy bike.

**Please note:** The children must attend all sessions to pass the course. When the children have been allocated their session, they cannot be moved.

In the event of there being more than 30 applicants we will make a draw of equal numbers of boys and girls and put the other names forward onto the reserve list.
