

Promoting British Values Across the Curriculum at Whybridge Junior School

The DfE has reinforced the need “*to create and enforce a clear and rigorous expectation on all schools to promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.*”

The government set out its definition of British values in the 2011 Prevent Strategy, and the Prime Minister has reiterated these values in 2014. At Whybridge Junior these values are reinforced regularly and in the following ways across the curriculum:
