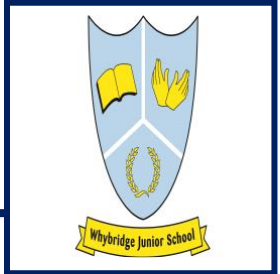

**Message from Mrs Warshow, Head of School**

You will be aware that, in the Prime Minister's speech on 10th May, he outlined plans for a phased re-opening of schools. This is proposed to take effect from Monday 1st June, with the first year groups to return being Year R, Year 1 and Year 6, followed by other year groups thereafter.

We are currently working on a detailed plan, including a thorough risk assessment, to ensure that we take every measure possible to keep pupils, staff and visitors safe. This includes considering the schools maximum capacity to open safely. Over the coming weeks we shall be communicating with you to provide further details on the arrangements for reopening.

Some of the safety measures we will be taking are:

- Limiting class sizes. Pupils may not be with their current teacher or in their usual classroom;
- Pupils will be taught in a 'class bubble' and will not mix with other classes.
- Start and end times to the school day will be staggered for different 'class bubbles', as will break and lunch times;
- New social distancing signage and markings will be present, both outside and inside the school building;
- Increased and enhanced cleaning of surfaces and resources;
- Increased and regular handwashing e.g. on arrival, before/after eating, after sneezing or coughing and, of course, after the toilet;
- Keeping pupils and staff with coronavirus symptoms at home;
- Extra anti-bacterial foam dispensers around school
