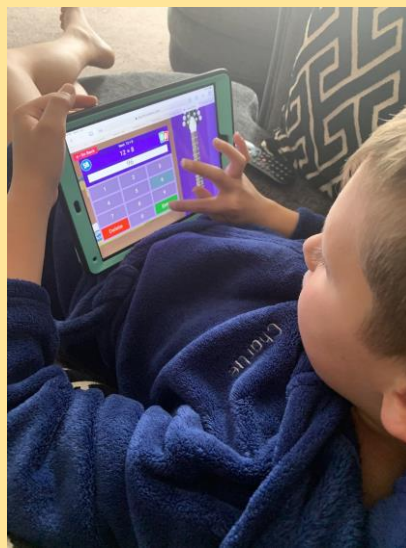
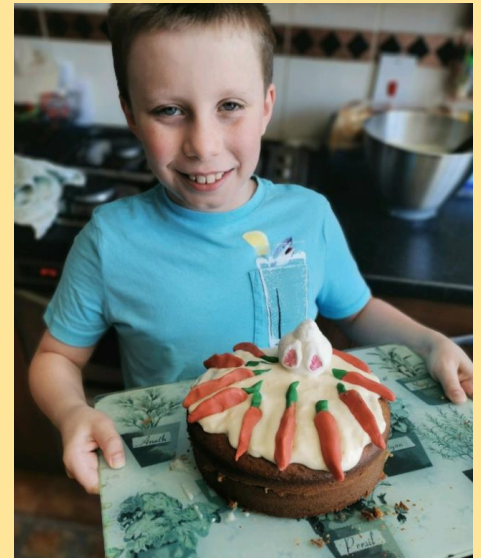

Free School Meal Hampers and Vouchers

Our kitchen has now reopened and so we will be returning to providing food hampers, rather than vouchers, for any children who are eligible for free school meals that are staying at home.
